Dr. Sabine Girod is the Chief of Stanford Oral Medicine & Maxillofacial Surgery (SOMMS). She received her DDS from the University of Bonn, Germany, her MD from the University of Hannover Germany, and her PhD from the University of Cologne, Germany. She trained in Oral and Cranio-Maxillofacial Surgery in Germany and completed a postdoctoral research fellowship at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute (Harvard Medical School) in Boston. Dr. Girod's special clinical and research interests are Oral Medicine and Maxillofacial Surgery, especially reconstruction of complex craniofacial injuries and maxillofacial deformities, including orthognathic surgery, bone replacement, distraction osteogenesis, osseointegrated implants and molecular mechanism of diseases of the oral mucosa.
